House Speaker Clay Schexnayder's House Bill 199 Advances to the Senate

BATON ROUGE, LA - Yesterday, HB199 by Speaker Schexnayder, overwhelmingly passed through the Louisiana House of Representatives with a vote of 97 to 4.

HB199 is a bi-partisan effort, led by Louisiana Speaker of the House Clay Schexnayder, that sets out to streamline Louisiana's outdated sales tax collection model, bringing Louisiana in line with the rest of the country.

"The House sent a message today. Both Republicans and Democrats came together and acted in the best interest of the families of this state," said Schexnayder.

"That's exactly what we're here to do. We've still got a ways to go, but today was a big day."

The bill now heads to the Senate for debate.
