I live in the Carrollton/Riverbend area of New Orleans, and while it's bad enough that we are lumped in with districts that are predominantly in Jefferson Parish, it looks like this map will have our neighborhood further split up between not 1, but 2 predominantly Jefferson Parish districts (#82 & #94)!!

This plan would seriously dilute our representation in government.

Besides that, while District #82 is at least somewhat contiguous, District #94 makes no sense at all.
