RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Proclamation issued December 22, 2010 by the Legislature of Louisiana calls the Legislature into Extraordinary Session beginning at 5:00 p.m. on the 20th day of March, 2011 and ending no later than 6:00 p.m. on the 13th day of April, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Item No. 7 of the call provides that the power to legislate at such session includes: "To adopt an Act relative only to the Courts of Appeal of Louisiana; to provide for the composition of the Courts of Appeal and the number of judges thereof; to provide for election districts for the Courts of Appeal; and to provide relative to the effectiveness of such districts";

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Judges of the Court of Appeal, First Circuit, support and are in favor of maintaining the present geographical boundaries of the First Circuit and support the concept of additional minority judgeships.
