



#### **Significant Requests**

- The department is not requesting any new and expanded services.
- Staffing The department did not request any change in authorized positions. The Contact Assistance program requested an additional \$688,000 in Interagency Transfers in anticipation of wage restructuring for the employees in each of the parish offices. The agencies requested \$25,000 in State General funds for merits.
- The Cemeteries program is requesting an additional \$235,000 in State General Fund for administrative costs due to low levels of burials in the Leesville and Rayville cemeteries, as well as \$77,000 to purchase new equipment to help with the maintenance of the cemeteries.
- The Military Family Assistance Fund saw an increase in spending due to the flooding of 2016 and is requesting a reduction of \$350,000, returning to more historically normal levels in FY18.
- There is a request to replace Fees and Self-Generated Revenues with federal dollars in the veterans' homes. Additional Federal Funding has become available upon an increase in the number of service-connected veterans that are allotted higher federal per diems.
- The veterans' homes are requesting an additional \$990,000 in Federal Funds in order to replace furniture, medical equipment, and make major repairs to the facilities.
