


Significant Requests

- No new and expanded requests have been included.
- The Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District (LSED) has no authorized positions. All services and employees are provided through a management contract with SMG, Inc. According to the agency, SMG employees received an average 2.5% salary increase in FY 16-17 and are anticipated to receive a similar increase in FY 17-18. See question 10 on page 5 of the agency response for more information on staffing.
- The LSED budget request is based on a flat 2.5% increase in Statutory Dedications and Fees and Self Generated Revenue based on historical trending. According to the agency, this does not reflect an increase in services or expansion of programs.
