
Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund Act 410 of 2021 Regular Session Total Funding= \$3,011,136,886

- The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 allocated \$3.011 billion to Louisiana from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund. This <u>does not</u> include the \$1.8 billion Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund or the \$179.8 million Coronavirus Capital Projects Fund.
- HB642 directs some of this funding into the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund to be used for various state initiatives.

Descriptions of usages:

- 1. Unemployment Compensation Fund (GOHSEP) Replenishes the fund from a zero balance to prevent further borrowing from the federal government and repay previously borrowed money
- 2. Water Sector Program (Division of Administration) Grants for community water and sewer systems, repairs, and improvements necessitated by storm water
- 3. LA Loggers Relief Program (State Treasury) Grants to eligible timber harvesting & hauling businesses effected by COVID-19
- 4. Louisiana Save Our Screens Program (State Treasury) Grants to eligible movie theaters impacted by COVID-19
- 5. Louisiana Small Business & Nonprofit Assistance Program (Department of Revenue) Grants to eligible small businesses and nonprofits for aiding individuals impacted by COVID-19
- 6. Louisiana Port Relief Program (DOA) Grants to Ports for revenue losses and expenses related to COVID-19
- 7. TTF Construction Subfund Transfer (DOTD) Funding utilized in HB2 for capital outlay road and infrastructure projects
- 8. Legislative Capitol Technology Enhancement Fund Transfer Funds for enhancing technology in the state Capitol
- **9.** Major Events Fund Transfer (Economic Development) Funding for attracting, hosting, and incentivizing major regional and statewide events to be conducted in Louisiana
- **10.** Southwest Louisiana Hurricane Recovery Fund Transfer (State Treasury) Funding to repair structural damage in Southwest Louisiana resulting from the 2020 hurricane season
- 11. Louisiana Tourism Revival Program (DOA & Culture, Recreation & Tourism) Support for state, local, and regional tourism entities to promote travel to Louisiana in both in-state and out-of-state markets
- 12. Health Care Employment Reinvestment Opportunity (HERO) Fund SB 229 contains the program to expand capacity for nursing education programs
- 13. Capital Outlay Relief Fund (Facility Planning)- Transfer of funds for future capital outlay projects
