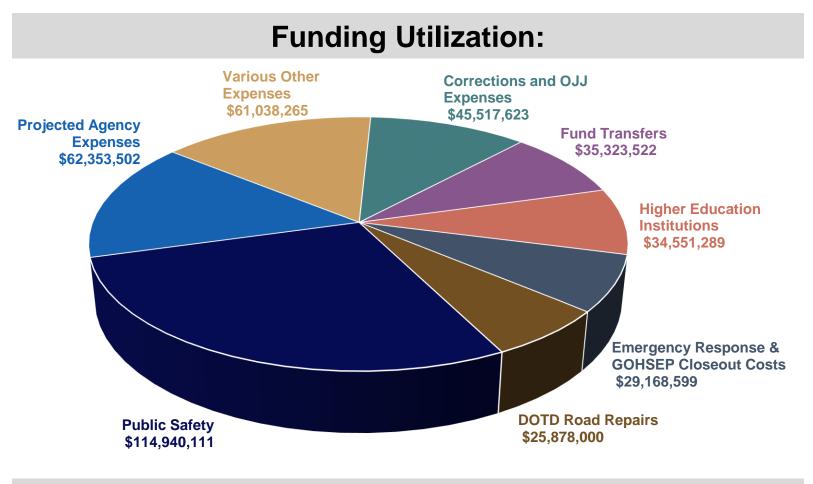
FY 2025 Excess State General Fund

Descriptions of Usages:

- 1. Public Safety Funding for means of finance substitutions to cover self-generated under collections and to meet anticipated year end expenses
- 2. Projected Agency Expenses Funding to ensure agencies meet anticipated year-end expenses
- 3. Various Other Expenses Appropriations to state agencies, local municipalities, and non-governmental orgs.
- Corrections & OJJ Expenses Funding to ensure the Department of Corrections and Office of Juvenile Justice meets anticipated year-end expenses (personnel expenses, upgrades, repairs, etc.)
- Fund Transfers State General Fund moved into specific special funds in the state treasury (detailed on page 2)
- 6. Higher Education Institutions Funds various higher education operating expenses and projects / initiatives
- 7. Emergency Response & GOHSEP Closeout Costs Funding for emergency response efforts and for payments to FEMA for the state cost share of expenses related to recent disasters
- 8. DOTD Road Repairs Funds for various road repair projects across the state

Fund Transfers:

Funding moved into special funds in the state treasury through directives in HB 461:

- \$25.3 M Overcollections Fund monies from this fund are appropriated for teacher pay stipends
- \$8 M Oilfield Site Restoration Fund costs associated with any oilfield site assessment or restoration conducted by the Department of Energy and Natural Resources (DENR)
- \$1 M Louisiana Outdoors Forever Fund – provides funding to the Louisiana Outdoors Forever Program in the Office of Wildlife and Fisheries for outdoor conservation projects in the state
- \$1 M Reading Enrichment and Academic Deliverables (R.E.A.D) Fund – administration and implementation of the R.E.A.D. Program

Other Means of Finance Fund Transfers:

- \$15 M from Department of Insurance Self-Generated Revenues into the Louisiana
 Fortify Homes Program Fund
- \$10 M from Mineral and Energy Operations Fund into the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund
